

VENUE F.A.Q'S

PARKING

Please be advised that parking is available on street in the village. Overflow parking is available for certain events at Clann Mhuire GAA club HPP4 + PXVillage, Naul Dublin. Please County consider local resident's access to their homes and businesses when parking in Naul village.

Public Transport:

TSEAC is accessible via two public transport routes running 7 days a week, Local Link Route 195 (between Balbriggan and Ashbourne) and Route 192 (between Swords and Balbriggan).

VENUE ACCESSIBILITY

At TSEAC, we are committed to ensuring that everyone has the best possible experience at our events. To make each visit enjoyable for all, we have implemented measures to provide accessible support throughout your visit. We guarantee universal access, with fully accessible entry into our theatre and Café. There are no steps to enter any of our buildings, ensuring ease of access for all guests. Maximum seated capacity - 15 seats

€20 per hour, during the hours of 9pm to 5pm, Monday to Friday*

THE THEATRE

Maximum seated capacity - 90 seats in rows

€30 per hour, during the hours of 9pm to 5pm, Monday to Friday*

THE PIPER'S GARDEN

(outdoor, under cover of stretch-tent)

Maximum seated capacity - 350 seats in rows

€40 per hour, during the hours of 9pm to 5pm, Monday to Friday*

Additional Costs:

An additional $\in 20$ per hour applies to all required spaces' hourly rental rates; if outside of office hours, at weekends, or on public holidays.

Additional Information:

*THESE RENTAL RATES ONLY APPLY TO THE EMPTY FLOOR SPACE.

If more (than a handful of) chairs are required, there is an additional minimum charge of 1 hour to allow staff to setup before your event and reset afterwards. There may be additional hours setup and reset depending on your exact requirements.

Details of your required setup, e.g. round tables with 4 chairs; trestle tables; rows of seats; must be discussed and agreed with a member of staff in advance.

No food or drinks may be consumed on-site unless discussed and agreed with a member of staff in advance.

To confirm your booking, a copy of your insurance must be provided, specifying indemnity to The Séamus Ennis Arts Centre and Fingal County Council.
